

A Kid's Place Drop In Child Care, Inc.

Dear Parent of a 4 year old (**must be 4 before school begins**),

Here is a little bit of information on our program. Spaces are limited to 10 children per class.

Our Goals

Our 4 Year Old Program goals are two-fold. The first goal is to assure that your child is able to successfully begin a Pre-K program. Our second goal is to assist in developing your child's confidence, self-image, and ability to interact in social as well as pre-academic environments. We plan on accomplishing the goals with your child by promoting age appropriate social skills and encouraging their intellectual curiosity.

Our Program

Our program will consist of three sessions each week- Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesday from 10:15-12:00. We believe in building upon knowledge so on Mondays we introduce a topic, on Tuesdays we build on the learned concepts and on Wednesdays we review. We have a new curriculum introducing **common core standards**. Our schedule will include a pre-academic and artistic curriculum. The academic area of study will include stories with an emphasis on comprehension and letter recognition, as well as mathematics emphasizing counting and sorting and number recognition. The artistic curriculum will include exposure to arts and crafts and music.

Throughout our program we will promote appropriate social behavior, self awareness, listening skills, following directions, lining up, and group learning. Although our childcare center encourages free play, this program will emphasize the pre-academic areas.

Tuition

The four year old program registration fee is \$75.00 per year, and is non-refundable. The registration fee and half of the first month's tuition along with the registration form are due when you sign your child up for the program. ($\$75+63= \138 due at Registration.)

Tuition is \$125.00 a month and is paid on a monthly basis, due at the first class of each month. A \$10 per week late fee will be charged if tuition is paid after the first week.

Children may arrive at the start of the session and must be picked up no more than 5 minutes after dismissal. Children here more than 5 minutes before or after the session will be transferred to the daycare staff and charged according to drop in rates.

Our Teacher

Ms. Alissa is a certified elementary and special needs teacher with an extra certification in early childhood education. She has been with us for 16 years and this is her 12th year teaching our preschool programs.

Parental Involvement

Parent involvement is absolutely minimal. You drop off and pick up your child. Remember that we sometimes have drop-in slots for before or after school care each day.
