

A Kid's Place Preschool

Dear Parent of a 3-year-old, (**must be 3 by August, NO EXCEPTIONS**),
Here is a little bit of information on our program. Spaces are limited to 10 children per class.

Our Goals

Our 3-Year-Old Program goal is to assist in the development of your young child's confidence and self-image, in a pre-academic environment. We will do this by promoting age-appropriate social skills and encouraging intellectual curiosity.

Our Program

Our program will consist of three sessions each week- Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 9:00-10:15. We believe in building upon knowledge so on Mondays we introduce a topic, on Tuesdays we build on the learned concepts and on Wednesdays we review. Our schedule will include a pre-academic and artistic curriculum. The academic area of study will include stories, comprehension, letter introduction, as well as early mathematics emphasizing counting and sorting. The artistic curriculum will include exposure to arts and crafts, play and music.

Throughout our program we will promote appropriate social behavior, listening skills, following directions, lining up, and group learning. We do not require our 3-year-olds to be potty trained to attend our program. (We do suggest that families watch for signs that their child is ready.)

Tuition

The three-year-old program registration fee is \$75.00 per year and is non-refundable. The registration fee and half of the first month's tuition along with the registration form and all daycare paperwork are due when you sign your child up for the program. **\$143 due at Registration**
The second half of September's tuition is due on the first day of class.

Tuition is \$135.00 a month and is paid monthly, due at the first class of each month. A late fee of \$10 will be added for each week that tuition is late.

Children may arrive at the start of the session and must be picked up no more than 5 minutes after dismissal. Children here more than 5 minutes before or after the session will be transferred to the daycare staff and charged according to hourly rates.

Our Teacher

Ms. Alissa is a certified elementary and special needs teacher with an extra certification in early childhood education. She has been with us for 22 years and this is her 18th year teaching our preschool programs.

Parental Involvement

Parent involvement is minimal. You drop off and pick up your child. Remember that we sometimes have openings for before or after school care each day. Reservations are required ahead of time.
